
Thank you for choosing a YAMAHA VP-500 Volume Pedal. The VP-500 is a compact volume pedal designed to accept the output from high-impedance instruments such as electric guitar and bass. For maximum versatility the VP-500 features a minimum volume control and a tuner output jack.

## OPERATION


- 1. Connect the output from your guitar to the VP-500 IN jack.
- Connect the OUT jack of the VP-500 to the input jack of your amplifier or effect unit.
- Press the pedal all the way down and set the maximum desired volume using the amplifier volume control.
- 4. With the pedal all the way up, use the Minimum Volume control on the VP-500 to set the minimum desired volume level. Rotating the Minimum Volume control clockwise increase the minimum volume level i.e. the total pedal volume control range is decreased.

## USING A TUNER

An electronic guitar tuner can be connected to the VP-50 TUNER OUT jack, and used to tune the guitar connected to the IN jack when the pedal is all the way up (the minimum volum position).
